The Village of Ashville reviewed the United States Access Board and 36 CFR Part 1191 RIN 3014-AA@@. The ADA Restroom pictured below is connected to the existing track. As part of the project we will ensure signage is in place the will assist anyone on the proposed Roundabout Trail directions to that restroom. In addition there are no breaks in connecting the trail, sidewalk, and existing pavement.



There are five Handicap Parking Spaces on the Westside of the Park that have complete access to the trail and to the restrooms that are ADA compliant and were part of a nature WORKS Grant. If the purposed Roundabout Trail is approved better signage to communicate that information will be installed.

To the south there is the south parking lot and the Ashville Elementary Parking Lot which has Handicap parking and complete access from those location to the purposed Roundabout Trail.
