For all household members:

- Names, Date of Birth & Social Security Number(s)
- Current or previous address
- Copies of Social Security cards or verification for each household member
- Proof of income
- Hardship due to COVID-19 pandemic

For the assistance requested:

- Notice of past due rent, mortgage (including taxes and insurance), and/or copies of utility bills demonstrating past due or disconnection status

What is the Home Relief Grant?

The State of Ohio has allocated \$50 M from the Coronavirus Relief Fund, made available through the CARES Act, to 47 Community Action Agencies who serve all 88 Ohio counties. The grant will help Ohioans who have experienced economic hardship as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic with past due rent, mortgage, water, and sewer payments.

Who is eligible?

Ohio households with an annual income at or below 200% Federal Poverty Level, and who are past due on rent, mortgage, water, and/or sewer payments are eligible. For a family of four, that annual income level is up to \$52,400.

How do I apply?

Ohio's Home Relief Grant

Rent, Mortgage, Water, Sewer

Ohioans who are behind on their rent, mortgage, water, and/or sewer payments may be eligible for assistance through the Coronavirus Relief Fund made available by the CARES Act.

Households at or below 200% FPL and who have been impacted by COVID-19
