Regarding: Application for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funding for West Station Street Improvement Project (Resurfacing, ADA Compliant Sidewalks and stormwater)

Dear Commissioners:

For the 2017 CDBG Application the Village of Ashville will be submitting two (2) project. This will be a priority one (1) project and resurfacing the roadway, installing ADA approved sidewalks and improving water drainage on West Station Street between Randolph Street and Long Street (State Route 316). This project will connect islands of sidewalks within the Village. It will also add to our program to link these islands of sidewalks and trails within the Village, see application exhibits.

The Percentage of LMI Persons is 60.0 to 100.0%. That information is in the Exhibits for the CDBG Application.

The funds that would be used by the Village of Ashville are General Fund Street Department Contractual 1000-670-399-0000, Street Department Other 1000-670-690-0000, and Permissive Motor Vehicle License 2101-610-396-0000. The Contingency Fund of Ashville 1000-930-930-5001 would be used as a reserve fund for 2101-610-396-0000.
