The Council of Ashville convened in Regular Session from 6:30 PM to 7:43 PM in the Council Meeting Room at 200 East Station Street, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Mayor Wise called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Roger Clark said his statement in the minutes regarding the \$100K revenue from TVSD needs to reflect that that figure was through August 2020. Clark then moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the minutes of the September 28, 2020 Regular Session as corrected. All votes were yea.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: The VA reported that he had become aware that some picnic tables and benches in the park were in bad shape and could be unsafe. The VA said that he contacted the Pickaway County Park District who had originally issued grant money for replacement of the open shelter house roof and asked if the grant money could be used to replace the picnic tables and benches instead and they said yes. David Rainey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to have the VA to move forward with making the park purchases. Christman closed his report with a slide-show presentation of the progress that has been made with the SR 316 paving project.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: At 6:52 PM Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to go into Executive Session to discuss a legal matter. All votes were yea. The Executive Session adjourned at 7:12 PM and the Regular Session resumed.

LEGISLATION**ORDINANCE(S) FOR THIRD READING**

2020-08 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OR MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TEAYS VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR USE OF THE VILLAGE'S WATER TOWER FOR PLACEMENT OF A COMMUNICATION ANTENNA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by David Rainey, to postpone the Third Reading until the October 26, 2020 Council meeting and put topic on the October 19 Committee of the Whole agenda for discussion. All votes were yea.

RESOLUTION(S) FOR FIRST READING

11-2020 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS BETWEEN ACCOUNTS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 2020-03, THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to have the First Reading. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to accept the First Reading, suspend the Rules of Council, waive the Second and Third Readings, and adopt as an emergency measure. All votes were yea.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Wise reported that at the onset of Covid-19 shutdowns and the financial uncertainty of its impact on the village's budget, he imposed a spending and hiring freeze. Wise reported that the village so far seems to be doing ok and he has officially lifted the freeze.

GUEST(S): Sandi Oliver asked how much grant money the village is eligible for from the Pickaway County Parks Foundation and Christman told her that it's not a fixed number that the figure changes annually. In addition to noting the declining condition of the benches and picnic tables, Oliver pointed out that one of the steps on the gazebo has a hole in it and many trees have limbs that pose a danger. Franklin Christman stated the bucket truck was currently down so the Service Department isn't able to get to the branches. Nelson Embrey asked how much it will cost to fix the bucket truck and Greg Sturgill said approximately \$3500.
