MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Roger Clark moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the minutes of the October 5, 2020 Regular Session as presented. All votes were yea.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: The VA reported that the 316 paving project is moving north and he expects paving to start soon. ORDINANCE(S) FOR THIRD READING

2020-08 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OR MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TEAYS VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR USE OF THE VILLAGE'S WATER TOWER FOR PLACEMENT OF A COMMUNICATION ANTENNA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to have the Third Reading. All votes were yea.
