LEGISLATION

ORDINANCE(S) FOR FIRST READING

2020-09 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2008-07 CHANGING THE SYSTEM CAPACITY CHARGE FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER IN THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE. THIS CHANGE WILL NOT CONFLICT WITH ANY OHIO REVISED CODE (ORC) LIMITATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Tracie Sorvillo, to have the First Reading. All votes were yea. Nelson Embrey asked the VA to round the figures to the nearest dollar. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to accept the First Reading. All votes were yea.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Wise reported that he and the Village Administrator met with a developer who is very interested in building a housing development in Ashville. Wise said they don't have a lot of details yet but will keep Council updated as information comes in.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

2. Nelson Embrey asked the VA if he had made any contact with South Bloomfield and the VA said no. Embrey then asked the VA how things were going on the antenna/water tower agreement with TVSD. The VA said he had just sent the letter today so they haven't had time to respond.
