ASHVILLE COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION

Held: JANUARY 25, 2021

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The Council of Ashville convened in Regular Session from 6:37 PM to 7:01 PM in an online meeting provided by Microsoft Teams. Mayor Wise called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Nelson Embrey reported the minutes for the December 21, 2020 meeting need to reflect that he chaired the meeting, not Mayor Wise. Nelson Embrey then moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the minutes of the January 4, 2021 Regular Session as corrected. All votes were yea.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: The VA read his written report which included Covid-19 vaccination updates and reported that PICCA is offering free transportation for residents who need transportation to the various vaccination locations throughout the county. The VA also reported that he had submitted the parks grant application for resurfacing the walking track in the park. Nelson Embrey asked the VA if he had received any information from South Bloomfield on the water plant. The VA said not yet.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: Chief George read his December 2020 monthly report.

TAX ADMINISTRATOR: Nelson Embrey noted that tax revenue was down for 2020 so we need to keep that in mind when working on the permanent appropriations for 2021. Roger Clark moved, seconded by Nelson Embrey, to approve the Tax Administrator's report. All votes were yea.

LEGISLATION

ORDINANCE(S) FOR FIRST READING

2021-01 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF TEAYS VALLEY LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR A PORTION OF PROPERTY AT PARCEL NUMBER D1300050209100, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Tracie Sorvillo, to have the First Reading. All votes were yea. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to accept the First Reading, suspend the Rules of Council, waive the Second and Third Readings, and adopt as an emergency measure. All votes were yea.

NEW BUSINESS: Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the Ohio Plan's 2021 proposal. All votes were yea.

CLERK/FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT:

1. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to approve the November 2020 Financial Reports. All votes were yea.
2. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve payment for the invoices payable to Digger McCray in the amounts of \$3400, \$3750 and \$4300. All votes were yea.
3. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to approve payment to Bill Toole for plan review fees in the amount of \$10,762.19. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS:

1. Randy Loveless asked when Council will begin meeting in person again. Mayor Wise said once the county is out of the red.
2. Nelson Embrey encouraged everyone to get the Covid-19 vaccine.

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- 3. David Rainey said the apothecary is now vaccinating residents but supplies are limited so there is no guarantee everyone will get one right away.

GUEST(S):


