ORDINANCE(S) FOR SECOND READING

2021-02 AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR'S EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, BASED UPON THE AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF RESOURCES ISSUED BY THE PICKAWAY COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE(S) FOR FIRST READING

2021-04 AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CURRENT REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE ASHVILLE CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to have the First Reading. All votes were yea. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to accept the First Reading, suspend the Rules of Council, waive the Second and Third Readings, and adopt as an emergency measure. All votes were yea.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE: Mayor Wise reported that Council met on February 8 and reviewed the 2021 Permanent Appropriations and discussed resuming in-person meetings in March.

CLERK/FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT:

1. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to issue payment to Digger McCray for repairs on multiple water main breaks in the amount of \$35,885 and to Buckeye State Pipe & Supply Co. for parts to repair multiple water main breaks in the amount of \$3,440.98. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS:

1. Nelson Embrey reported that the Finance Committee will meet March 5 at 6:00 to audit the third and fourth quarters' financial records for 2020.
2. Darryl Ward asked if the privately owned building that sits partially on the lot of the new water tower will have to be moved. The VA said that unless it presents a problem, it will not have to be moved. Council advised the VA to, as a courtesy, inform the owner of the building that it is partially on our property and, even though we aren't concerned with structure, it could present problems if the owner ever decided to sell his home.
