ASHVILLE COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION

Held: MARCH 15, 2021

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The Council of Ashville convened in Regular Session from 6:32 PM to 7:24 PM in the Council Meeting Room at 200 East Station Street, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Mayor Wise called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Randy Loveless moved, seconded by Tracie Sorvillo, to approve the minutes of the March 1, 2021 Regular Session as presented. All votes were yea.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: The VA reported that a resident contacted him about the storage unit outside the Dollar General store. Christman said he is researching how other municipalities handle storage units and will prepare legislation for Council to review.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: Chief George read his February monthly report and reported that April 24 is the annual drug takeback day. George said residents can drop off any unused drugs at Harrison Township Fire Department on that day. Chief George also said there were some issues with streets being cleared during the last snow storm because cars were not removed from the streets. George asked Council at what point does the PD enforce the snow emergency ordinance and tow vehicles. Mayor Wise said the problem is that we don't have any place to put the vehicles that get towed. Council discussed possible solutions to the issue but nothing was settled.

TAX ADMINISTRATOR: Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by David Rainey, to approve the Tax Administrator's February report. All votes were yea.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT: Greg Sturgill said he is reviewing bids for tree removal in the park and bids for concrete pads for the picnic tables. Sturgill also suggested getting rid of the grand stand in the park.

LEGISLATION

ORDINANCE(S) FOR THIRD READING

2021-02 AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR'S EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, BASED UPON THE AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF RESOURCES ISSUED BY THE PICKAWAY COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by David Rainey, to have the Third Reading. All votes were yea. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to accept the Third Reading and adopt as an emergency measure. All votes were yea.

ORDINANCE(S) FOR FIRST READING

2021-05 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE FLOW MONITORING AS MANDATED BY THE OHIOEPA IN THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to have the First Reading. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to accept the First Reading. All votes were yea.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE: Mayor Wise reported that Council met on March 8 and discussed a storage unit ordinance, putting together a Tax Advisory Board, and the proposed PUD.

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FINANCE COMMITTEE: Nelson Embrey reported that the Finance Committee met on March 4 to audit the 2020 Third and Fourth Quarters' financial reports and that all documents appeared to be in order.

CLERK/FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT:

1. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Tracie Sorvillo, to approve the January 2021 financial reports. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS:

1. David Rainey said the apothecary is still doing Covid shots and encouraged everyone to get theirs and asked if the park will be ready for rentals in September. The VA said possibly.
2. Darryl Ward reported that he had been contacted by two businesses who each would like to donate \$500 to purchase flags for the village.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Wise asked the VA if he had an update up the SR 316 project. The VA said the project should be completed by June 2021.

At 7:24 PM, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to adjourn the meeting. All votes were yea and the meeting adjourned.
