ASHVILLE COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION

Held: APRIL 5, 2021

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The Council of Ashville convened in Regular Session from 6:36 PM to 7:22 PM in the Council Meeting Room at 200 East Station Street, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Mayor Wise called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Randy Loveless moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to approve the minutes of the March 15, 2021 Regular Session as presented. Nelson Embrey pointed out that the minutes need to reflect that Ordinance 2021-02 was adopted as an emergency measure. Embrey then moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the March 15, 2021 minutes as corrected. All votes were yea.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: The VA read his monthly report which included updates on Covid-19 and the SR 316 paving project. The VA also said he had legislation ready to move forward with funding the Center Alley storm water improvement project. Darryl Ward asked if the railroad was going to help with any of the costs involved in the project. The VA said the will. Nelson Embrey asked if ODOT was going to fix the hump in the road on Main Street when they finish the SR 316 project. The VA said that is a railroad issue, not ODOT.

04-2021 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS TO COMPLETE AND FUND AN OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION PROJECT CENTER ALLEY STORMWATER OUTFALL(RAILROAD) IMPROVEMENT IN THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE AND TO EXECUTE OTHER CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED. David Rainey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to have the First Reading. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to accept the First Reading, suspend the Rules of Council, waive the Second and Third Readings, and adopt as an emergency measure. All votes were yea.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING & ZONING: Darryl Ward reported that P&Z met on March 31 to review a preliminary plan for a new housing development and discuss an apartment complex going in behind the apothecary. Ward said his

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only concern about the apartments is the entrance and exit. Roger Clark asked if the current water plant can handle this kind of growth. Mayor Wise said it can.

CLERK/FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT:

1. Randy Loveless moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to approve the February 2021 financial reports. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS:


1. Tracie Sorvillo said she ran into Ryan Scribner and he would like to come to a meeting to give up date on what's going on in the county.
