Held: APRIL 19, 2021

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Randy Loveless moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to approve the minutes of the April 5, 2021 Regular Session as presented. All votes were yea.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: The VA reported that the SR 316 paving project has resumed and the village was approved for an OPWC grant up to \$80K for the Center Alley Stormwater Improvement project and he will send out for bids in May. The VA also requested a Public Hearing for the annexation of the Runkle property on June 21. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Tracie Sorvillo, to have the Public Hearing Monday, June 21 at 6:15 PM. All votes were yea.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: Chief George read his monthly report and reminded everyone that Saturday is National Drug Take-Back Day and that people can drop off unused medications at the Harrison Township Fire Department.

TAX ADMINISTRATOR: Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Tracie Sorvillo, to approve the Tax Administrator's March 2021 report. All votes were yea.

RESOLUTION(S) FOR FIRST READING

05-2021 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO COMPLETE AERIAL MAPPING SURVEY IN THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to have the First Reading. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to accept the First Reading, suspend the Rules of Council, waive the Second and Third Readings and adopt. All votes were yea.

06-2021 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS BETWEEN ACCOUNTS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-02, THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to have the First Reading. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to accept the First Reading, suspend the Rules of Council, waive the Second and Third Readings, and adopt as an emergency measure. All votes were yea.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE: Mayor Wise reported that Council accepted Marc Cain's bid for tree service in the park. Wise also reported that the developer of the luxury apartments in South Bloomfield asked if the village would be interested in having similar apartments developed in the village and Council advised him to submit plans for review.

CLERK/FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT:

1. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to approve payment to National Water Services for pump repairs in the amount of \$3743 and to Mid-Ohio Electric Co., Inc. for WWTP bearings in the amount of \$3200.

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1. Roger Clark said he's glad to see that the trees in the park are getting taken care of.
 2. Darryl Ward said the K of P Lodge is making good progress on get the flags hung around the village.
