ORDINANCE(S) FOR FIRST READING

2021-09 AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REZONING OF THE FOUR-POINT-FOUR-TWO-THREE (4.423+/-) ACRE TRACT OWNED BY CONCOURSE 9 LLC FROM GENERAL BUSINESS (GB) TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to have the First Reading. All votes were yea, with the exception of Tracie Sorvillo, who voted no.
