### **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:**

David Rainey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the January 24, 2022 Regular Session minutes as presented. All votes were yea.

### **DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS**

**VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR:** Franklin Christman pulled up ashvilleohio.gov and reviewed the new public hearing and project pages he added to keep the public informed on the many projects and developments going on in the Village. Christman said the website will be updated regularly with the most current information and is the public's best resource for keeping informed.

### **FISCAL OFFICER:**

- Roger Clark moved, seconded by Steve Welsh, to approve payment to the Pickaway County Engineer Department in the amount of \$11,172.55 for the Village's portion of the Cromley Road paving project. All votes were yea.
- David Rainey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the December 2021 Financial Report. All votes were yea, except for Steve Welsh and Matt Scholl, who abstained.

### **COMMITTEES**

**PLANNING & ZONING:** Nelson Embrey asked P&Z Chairman, Jason Bartholow if he would like to report anything for P&Z. Bartholow said the committee discussed raising impact fees so the Village can develop recreational facilities like what Groveport has. Embrey said the VA is already looking into that.

**FINANCE:** Nelson Embrey reported that the Finance Committee met prior to the evening's meeting to perform a mini-audit of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2021 financial records. Embrey stated that everything appeared to be in order.

**UTILITIES:** Steve Welsh reported that the VA issued a press release requesting statements of qualification and that they are reading to get moving on the new water treatment plant.

### **COMMENTS:**

Roger Clark asked if the Village can insist that the PUD developers put in playgrounds. Franklin Christman said yes, that all can be discussed and decided during the planning phase.

Randy Loveless and David Rainey expressed their appreciation to the Street Department for a job well-done when plowing the streets during the recent snow accumulation.

Matt Scholl said he and Fire Chief Noggle had to reschedule their Safety Committee meeting with the date TBD.

At 7:00 PM, David Rainey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to adjourn the meeting. All votes were yea and the meeting adjourned.




