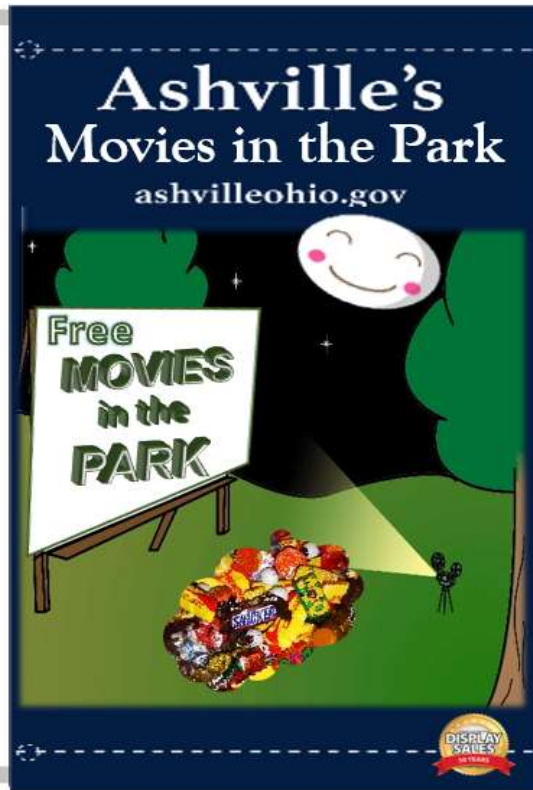

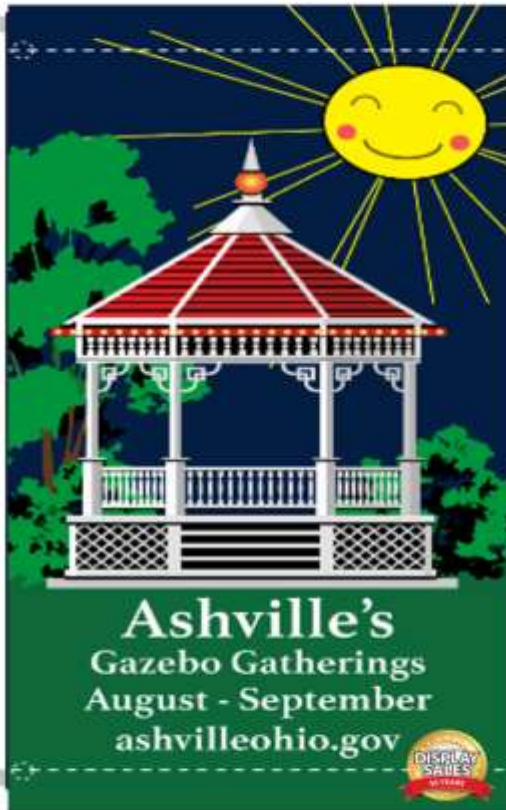

The events will be held near the shelter houses.

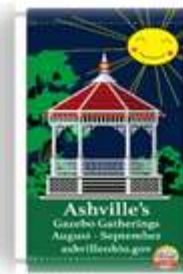
Picnic will begin at 4pm followed by a free concert featuring Ashville's very own The Raineys!

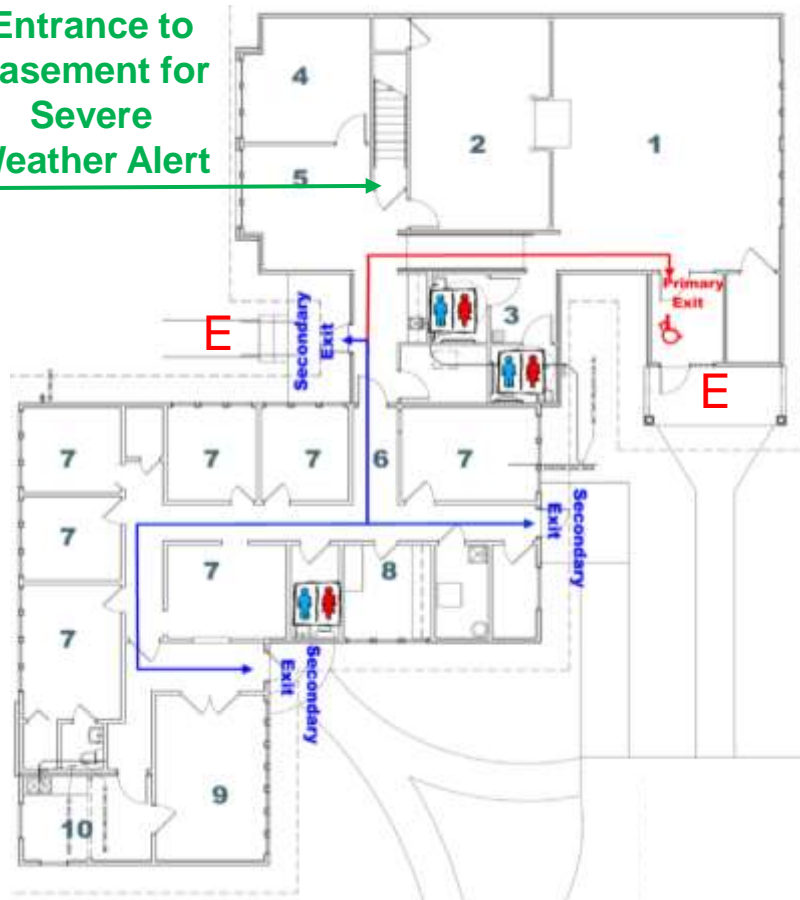
