DECEMBER 14, 2020

Nelson Embrey called the meeting to order at 6:36 PM. Answering roll call were Roger Clark, Randy Loveless, Nelson Embrey, Tracie Sorvillo and Darryl Ward. David Rainey was excused. Mayor Wise joined the meeting at 6:39 PM. Also present were Franklin Christman and Adam Trimmer.

MINUTES: Randy Loveless moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to approve the November 10, 2020 minutes as presented. All votes were yea with the exception of Tracie Sorvillo who abstained.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Franklin Christman reported that a revised version of the 2021 Temporary Appropriations ordinance was ready, as well as the annexation of the Runkle property. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to put the revised 2021 Temporary Appropriations ordinance on the agenda for the December 21 meeting. All votes were yea. Roger Clark moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to put the Runkle property ordinance on the December 21 agenda as well. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Nelson Embrey noted that he learned that the state has budgeted over \$208M for water improvements and encouraged the VA to look into getting some funding. Embrey also asked the VA if any of the high water usage issues had been resolved. The VA said they are working on it.
2. Roger Clark asked when the new Service Department employee starts and the VA said he will start this Wednesday.
3. Darryl Ward reported that the K of P's annual Christmas tree sale was successful.

Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to adjourn. All votes were yea and the meeting adjourned at 7:01 PM.
