VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Franklin Christman reviewed the 2021 Permanent Appropriations ordinance. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to put the ordinance on the next Council meeting's agenda for the first reading. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Nelson Embrey asked if solar energy was an option for the village. The VA said not likely. Embrey also stated that he would like to have a Finance Committee meeting as soon as Council begins meeting in person again.
2. Tracie Sorvillo asked when health insurance will renew and if we have the new rates. The Fiscal Officer said renewal is May 1 and that the new rates have not been announced.
3. Roger Clark asked if the K of P had received any flag donations. Darryl Ward said they had received one and the Fiscal Officer reported that a donation had been sent to the village office and was forwarded to Jim Welsh of the K of P. Clark asked David Rainey how the second Covid vaccination shot compared to the first. Rainey said it depends on the person but his second shot was tough.

Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to adjourn. All votes were yea and the meeting adjourned at 6:58 PM.
