

VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
APRIL 12, 2021

Mayor Wise called the meeting to order at 6:31 PM. Answering roll call were Roger Clark, Randy Loveless, Nelson Embrey, Tracie Sorvillo, Darryl Ward and David Rainey. Also present were Franklin Christman, Greg Sturgill and Marc Cain.

MINUTES: Darryl Ward moved, seconded by David Rainey, to approve the March 8, 2021 minutes as presented. All votes were yea.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT: Greg Sturgill reported that the Service Department staff will demo the grandstand but he will be contracting an electrician to handle all the electrical aspects. Sturgill said he is reviewing a bid from Pritchard's Electric.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Marc Cain asked Council to reconsider the bid he submitted in November 2020 to cut down and clean-up the trees in the park. After discussion, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve Cain's bid. All votes were yea.
2. Developer Larry Wills approached Council about building an apartment complex in the village like the Hutchison Place apartments in South Bloomfield. Wills said he just wanted to see if the village would even consider having the development before submitting plans. Council said they are open to the idea and for Wills to submit plans to Planning & Zoning for review.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Franklin Christman reported that the SR 316 project is moving forward, he is still working on storage unit legislation, and the Teays Valley tower agreement will be closing soon. Christman also said he would like to use Dynotec, Inc. for aerial mapping. David Rainey moved, seconded by Tracie Sorvillo, to forward legislation to Council for approval. All votes were yea. Christman said he is also working on legislation to accept the Runkle property annexation. Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to forward legislation to Council for approval. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Roger Clark asked what was going on with the septic tank abandonment. Christman said they are currently working on the problem.
2. Randy Loveless asked if a resident takes matters to get rid of feral cats into their own hands, will that person get in trouble. Mayor Wise said live-trapping and relocating cats is legal.
3. Tracie Sorvillo asked the VA if he had spoken to Ryan Scribner about P3 updates. The VA said he hadn't.
4. Darryl Ward said they are still waiting on swivels for the flags.

Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to adjourn. All votes were yea and the meeting adjourned at 7:57 PM.
