Mayor Wise called the meeting to order at 6:40 PM. Answering roll call were Roger Clark, Nelson Embrey, Tracie Sorvillo, and Darryl Ward. Randy Loveless and David Rainey were excused. Also present was Franklin Christman.

MINUTES: Roger Clark noted the May 10 minutes need to reflect that he could hear talking at Kelli Jo's from the front of the building, not in front of his house. Darryl Ward moved, seconded by Roger Clark, to approve the May 10, 2021 minutes as corrected. All votes were yea.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Franklin Christman reported that Stines Excavating was the low bid on the Center Alley Outfall Project, he and Greg Sturgill are looking at reflective post caps for the perimeter of the park, and that two Fun-in-the-Sun events have been scheduled for July 8th and July 22nd. Darryl Ward asked the VA if the parade route for the Fourth of July Celebration will need to be rerouted. The VA said Long Street should be fine for parades.

MAYOR: Mayor Wise reported that the new curbs installed at the South Scioto Street entrance/exit at Main Street have created a single lane and the issue is being reviewed.

Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Darryl Ward, to adjourn. All votes were yea and the meeting adjourned at 7:12 PM.
