**OWNER-CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT**

WITNESSETH, that the Contractor and the Owner for the consideration stated herein agree as follows:

ARTICLE I – SCOPE OF WORK

The Contractor shall perform everything required to be performed and shall provide and furnish all the labor, materials, necessary tools, expendable equipment, and all utility and transportation services required to perform and complete in a workmanlike manner all the work required for the construction of the Improvements of the Owner included in this Contract, all in strict accordance with the Contract Drawings and Specifications, including any and all Addenda, and in strict compliance with the Contractor's Proposal and the Other Sections of the Contract Documents herein mentioned which are a part of this Contract, and the Contractor shall do everything required by this Contract and the other documents constituting a part hereof.

In such accounting, the Owner shall not be held to obtain the lowest figures for doing of the work, or any part thereof, but all sums actually paid therefore shall be charged to the Principal or Surety. In this connection, from date of payment of Final Estimate, shall keep said work so constructed under said Contract in good order and repair, excepting only such part or parts of said work which may have been disturbed without the consent or approval of said Principal after the final acceptance of the same, and shall whenever notice is given as herein before specified, at once proceed to make repair as in said notice directed, shall pay in full all such subcontractors, material men, and laborers having a just claim in such repairs, or shall reimburse said Owner for any expense incurred by making such repairs, should the Principal or Surety fail to do as herein before specified, and shall fully indemnify, defend and save harmless the Owner from all suits and actions for damages of every name and description brought or claimed against it for or on account of any injury or damage to person or property received or sustained by any party or parties, by or from any of the acts or omissions or through the negligence of said Principal, servants, agents, or employees, in the protection of the work included in said Contract, then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

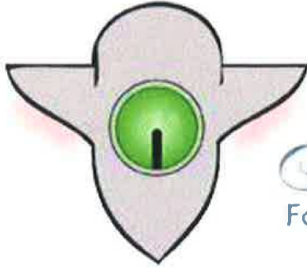
