Dear Messrs. Carter and Christman:

The Ohio Rail Development Commission of Ohio (ORDC) proposes one (1) crossing for the federally funded Grade Crossing Surface Reconstruction Program at the subject grade crossing. This location has been identified through a joint effort between NS, the Village of Ashville and ORDC.

Work performed by NS will conform to master Reconstruction Agreement number 2875 dated December 8, 1975, and Supplemental Reconstruction Agreement number 2875-A dated May 29, 1990, between the State of Ohio and Norfolk & Western Railroad except as defined by the terms of this letter agreement, and all applicable state and federal laws governing grade crossing safety programs. Construction shall be coordinated with the Village of Ashville's Griggs Street Railroad Crossing Relocation project.

The total actual costs for the improvements will be borne 90% by the ORDC and 10% by Village of Ashville and shall not exceed \$147,000.00 without prior written approval by ORDC. In addition, Village of Ashville will fund the asphalt approach work to the crossing.
