**Re: Water Resource Recovery Facility Part B**

Dear Neighbor:

Part B of the Water Resource Recovery Facility Project has been awarded to Fields Excavating, Inc. The facility, Part A, continues being constructed by Peterson Construction Company. Part B involves the installation of the infrastructure to connect the new facility to a pumping station at the current location and an effluent line from the new facility. That route will include Scioto Street, north up to Rich Street, west to Lexington and north to the new facility. At Rich another line will run up Rodgers Alley which is the alley between Lexington and Scioto Street. Construction began in January.

The contractor has reached the South Scioto Street section of the project. They will begin work on February 20<sup>th</sup>. The details of this section are on the reverse side of this page. 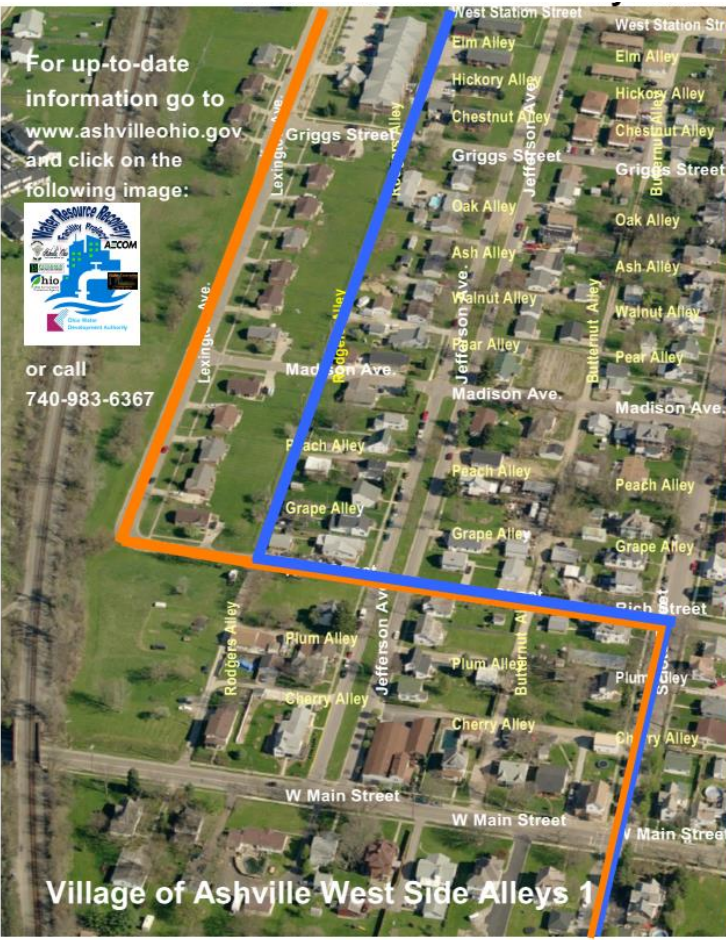
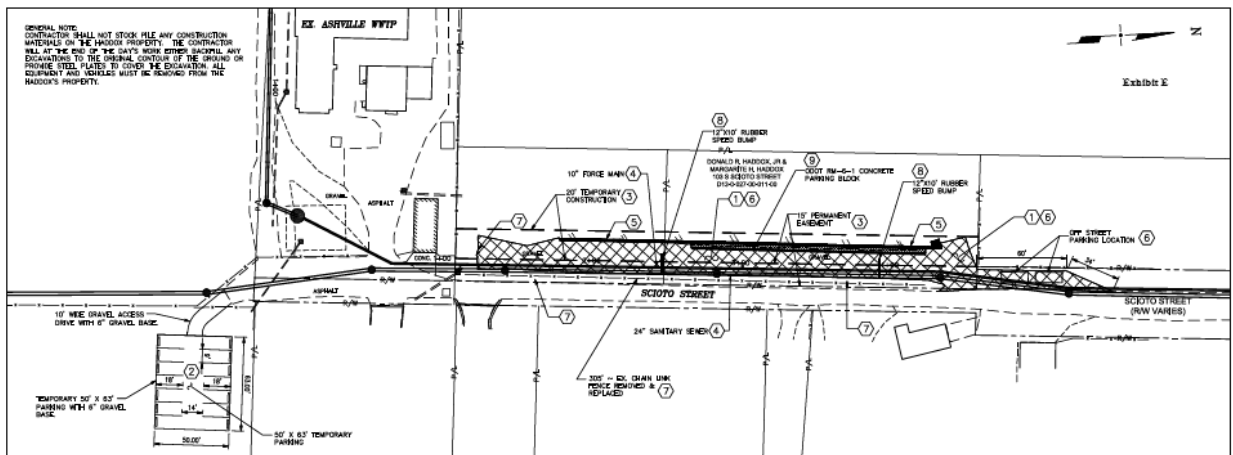
