Ashville Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF) Design
Period Ending January 2, 2015

The following work was completed by URS during the period:

1. Held internal design coordination review meetings with structural, electrical, architectural, plumbing and mechanical design staff.
2. Continued to prepare process, structural and electrical drawings and specifications for the WRRF in the Part A plans. Part A plans are now about 60% complete. A 60% set is being assembled for submittal to the Village in January.
3. Continued to finalize sanitary sewer and force main Part B plans and specifications. Part B plans are now about 90% complete.
4. Continued to meet with and request proposals from equipment manufacturers.
5. Continued detailed architectural, structural, mechanical and electrical design work on the administration building and other buildings.

2. Completed work on the PTI set of plans and specifications for the WRRF Part A and Part B projects. Printed 4 sets of plans and two sets of specifications and submitted them to the Ohio EPA.
3. Assisted Village staff with Ohio EPA, DEFA funding application. Submitted final application with attachments to the Ohio EPA.
4. Continued to work with gas company on a gas line relocation on Scioto Street near Main Street.
5. Revised sewer plan on Scioto Street to show new water line information provided by the Village.
