They requested forgiveness for the charges stating that there is no way to know who actually owned the home when the problem started making it impossible to determine whose usage is really reflected on their bill. The Committee deferred making a decision until more facts could be gathered regarding the issue.
2. Franklin Christman presented a Rights and Responsibilities pamphlet for the Committee's review.
