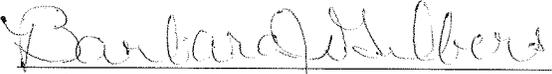
NEW BUSINESS: None

Gayle Blankenship moved, seconded by Glenn Cook, to approve the May 10, 2010 minutes as presented. All votes were yea.

UNFINISHED:

1. Vendor fees – Gayle Blankenship expressed her approval to waive vendor fees if the organization using the park compensates the park in other ways. General discussion of when to charge a fee, how much, per day or charge per event. VA instructed to research other municipalities and ordinances and report back.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Dog Park – Michele Glasspoole was present to discuss establishing a dog park. Glasspoole volunteered to obtain grants and to locate land and would like to have a “Bark in the Park” and dog furniture donated by the Boy Scouts as a project. Major expenses would be the acre of land and fencing. Blankenship stated there were several questions that needed addressed such as who would maintain the dog park, but felt maybe local vets would be willing to contribute. VA suggested working with Partner of Paws, Mingle with the Mutts and the local dog warden. Nelson Embrey suggested the possibility of using a portion of the wellfield. Mayor Wise invited all to the walk the wellfield property to determine how to use the entire area. Embrey suggested contacting dog food distributors for possible grants. Brian Garvine stated that committee was very interested and requested the VA to determine the dos and don'ts of the wellfield property.
