NEW BUSINESS:

1. Street Lights & Pedestrian Safety – discussion on the request from Ken Griffith for additional lighting at the intersection of Princeton and Dowling. VA stated that he felt a light should be at every crosswalk and that the current standards needed reviewed and updated. Christman stated that council must look at the village as a whole and not just according to subdivision. Standard to be reviewed when the P & Z Codebook is revised. VA instructed to respond to Mr. Griffith's email.
2. Morrison Drive – Gayle Blankenship requested No Parking on the pond side of Morrison Drive. Nelson Embrey requested Keith Moore to contact the Homeowners' Association and obtain approval to make Morrison Drive parking on one side. If granted the village will post signage.
3. Police Department – Mayor Wise stated he did not want to start the hiring process for a new Chief of Police until after the 2010 Appropriations ordinance had been passed. Wise advised that not only was the Chief's position open but an addition full-time officer was budgeted. Mayor Wise stated that instead of hiring a police officer a full-time clerical position might be a better fit in assisting the department with paperwork. No action taken at this time.

OLD BUSINESS:



NEW BUSINESS:


