

Public Water System Owner:

Thank you for your recent payment for the license to operate your public water system. Enclosed is your license to operate for 2019. The license should be on prominent display at your water system treatment plant. The license is property of the State of Ohio and must be surrendered to the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency upon revocation. The license is effective until January 30, 2020. The division will be sending out applications for 2020 licenses in the fall of 2019.

Ensure confidence in the quality of your water and save money by sampling on time. It costs an average of \$25 for each total coliform sample and \$20 for each nitrate sample. **Failing to sample for total coliform or nitrate will cost you \$150 or more in penalties for each monitoring violation. Save a Dime. Sample on Time!**
